
ANTH 3175/5175 - SS1 Field School in Historical Archaeology Bath State Historic Site





Bath was founded in 1705 and was North Carolina's first town and port of entry. This summer's dig will focus on the Palmer-Marsh house, Bath's oldest and in the colonial period its largest residence.
