








Archaeological Sites on the North Carolina Coastal Plain Within Elevations of 30 Feet Above Mean Sea Level



Map A shows all archaeological sites on file at the OSA within 30 feet of mean sea level. Map B shows those sites which are considered eligible for inclusion on the National Register of Historic Places. Map C shows those sites which contain or are associated with prehistoric shell middens. Map D shows NRHP sites inundated by a 1 meter rise in sea level. Water is shown in blue.
